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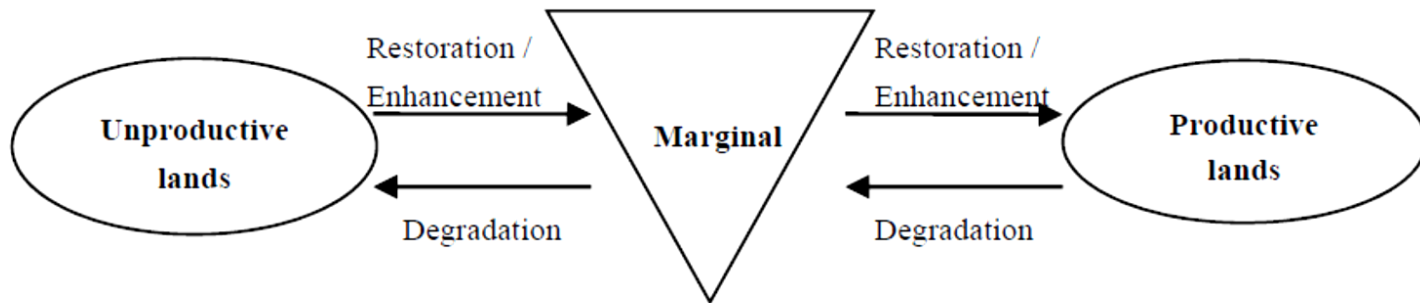

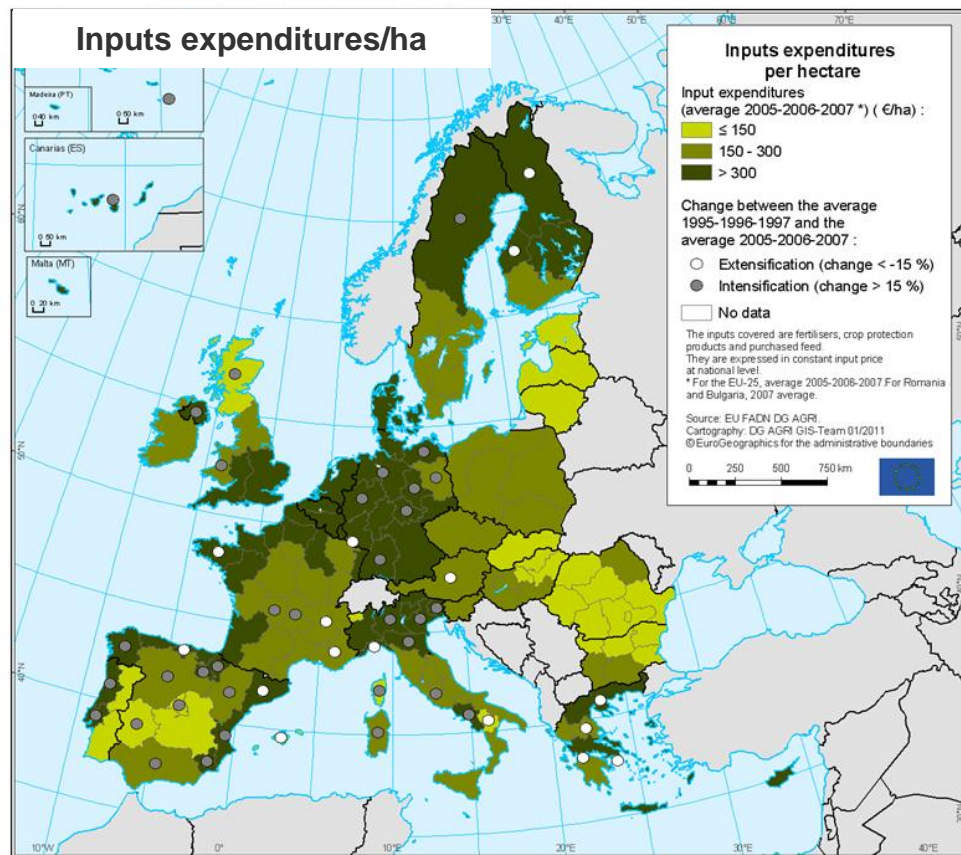
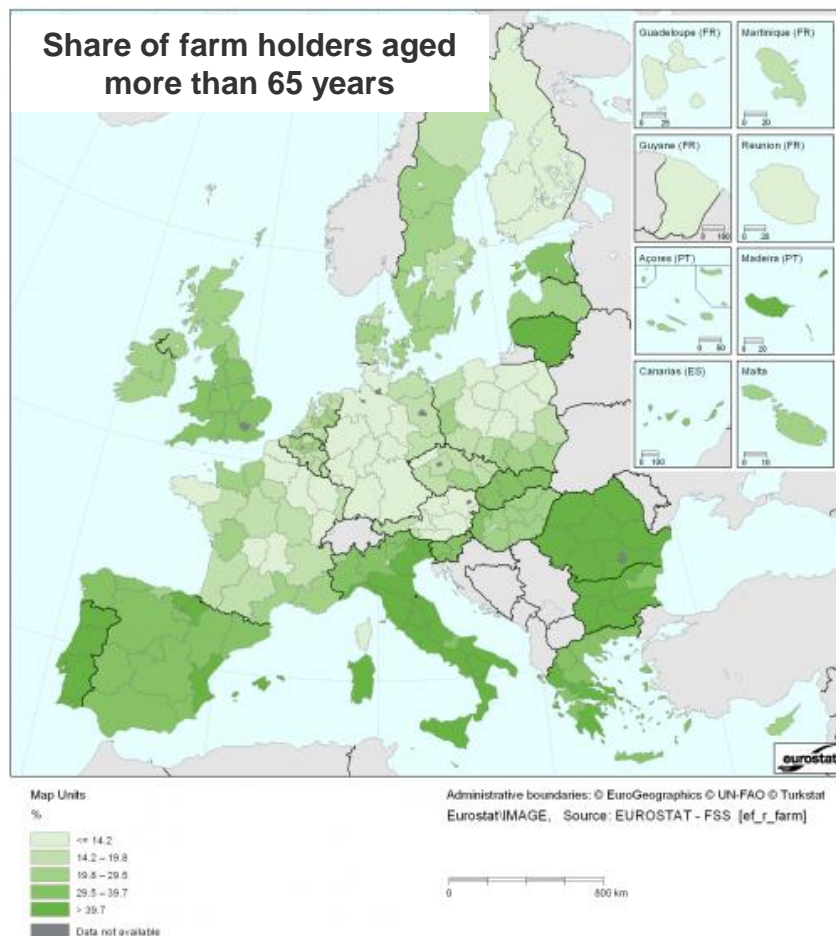


# Background

## *UNEP's Green Economy Report4:*

- *Growth in income and employment is driven by public and private investments that **reduce carbon emissions and pollution**, enhance energy and resource efficiency, and prevent the loss of biodiversity and ecosystem services.”*
- *Building green agriculture requires physical capital assets (.....) **crop and livestock diversification**;(.....); and appropriate farm level mechanization.*
- *Policy changes would particularly focus on the reduction and eventual removal of **ecologically perverse subsidies** that distort the true cost of unsustainable agricultural inputs.*

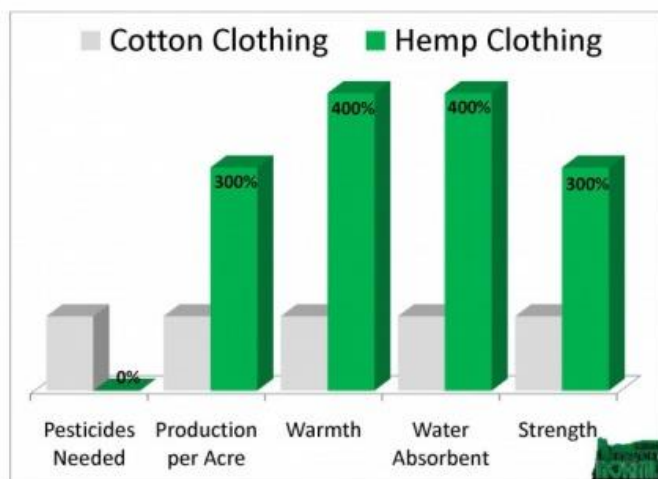
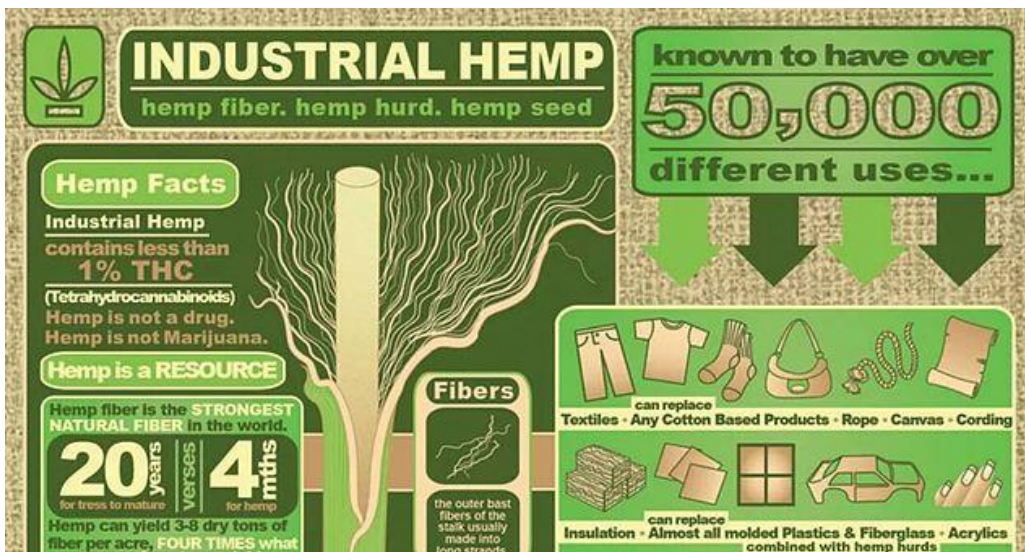
# Why Industrial Hemp?

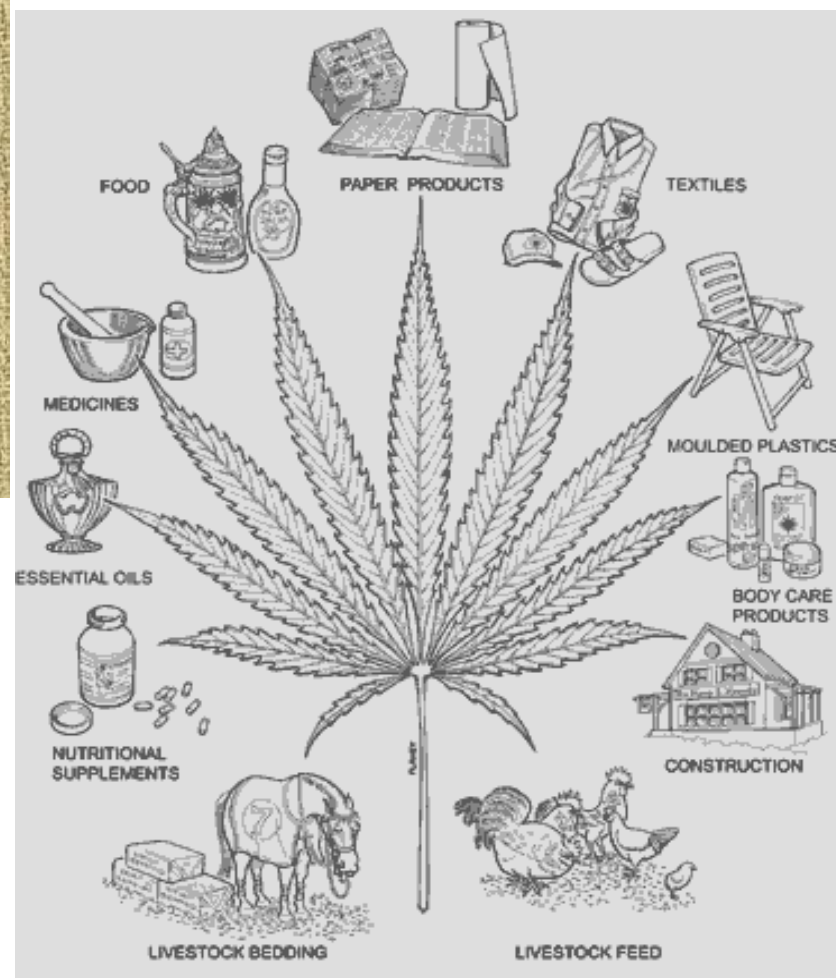
- Land abandonment / marginalization

Industrial Hemp is still a niche crop, cultivated on ca. 15,000 ha in the European Union (2012).

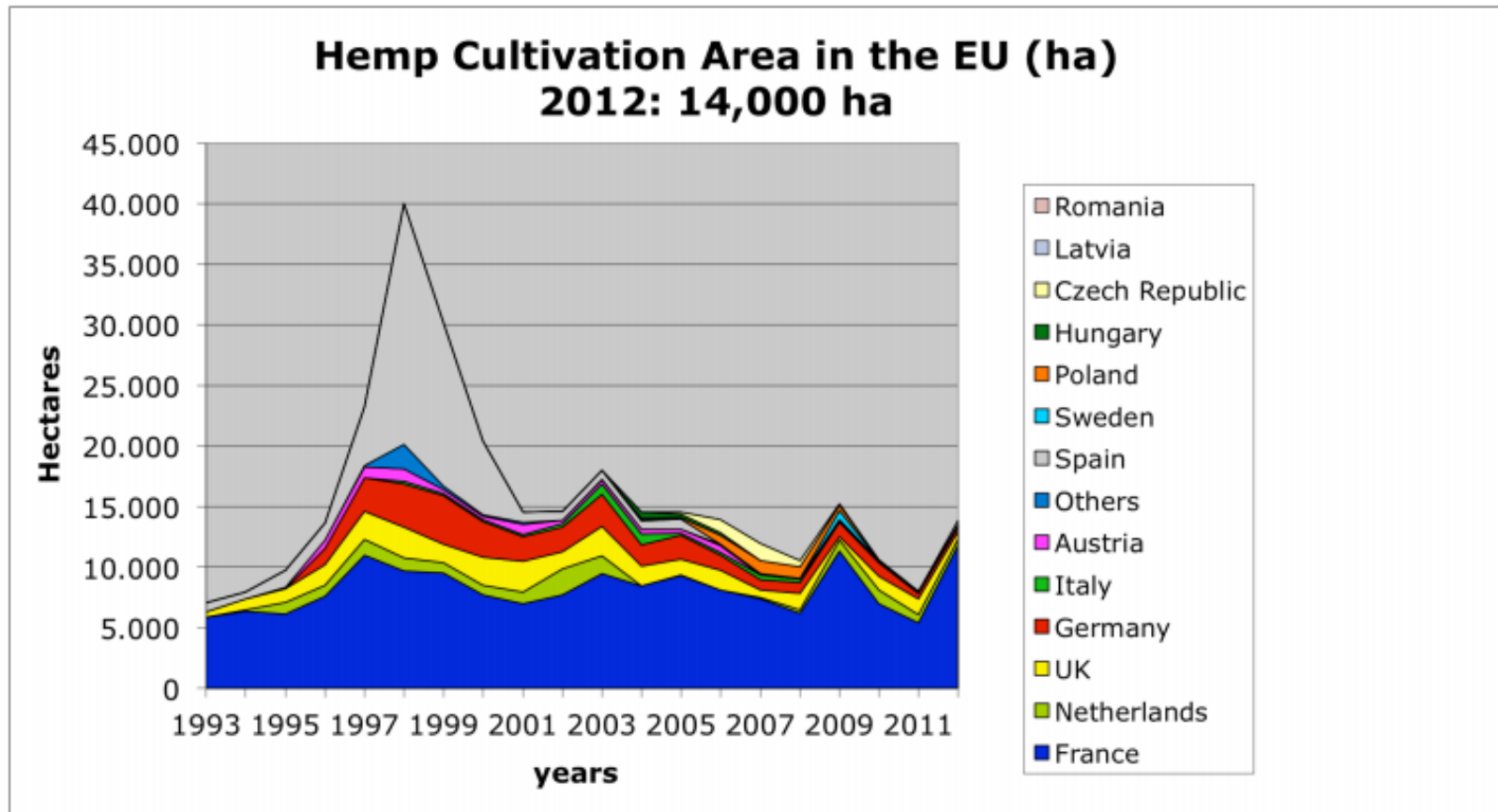
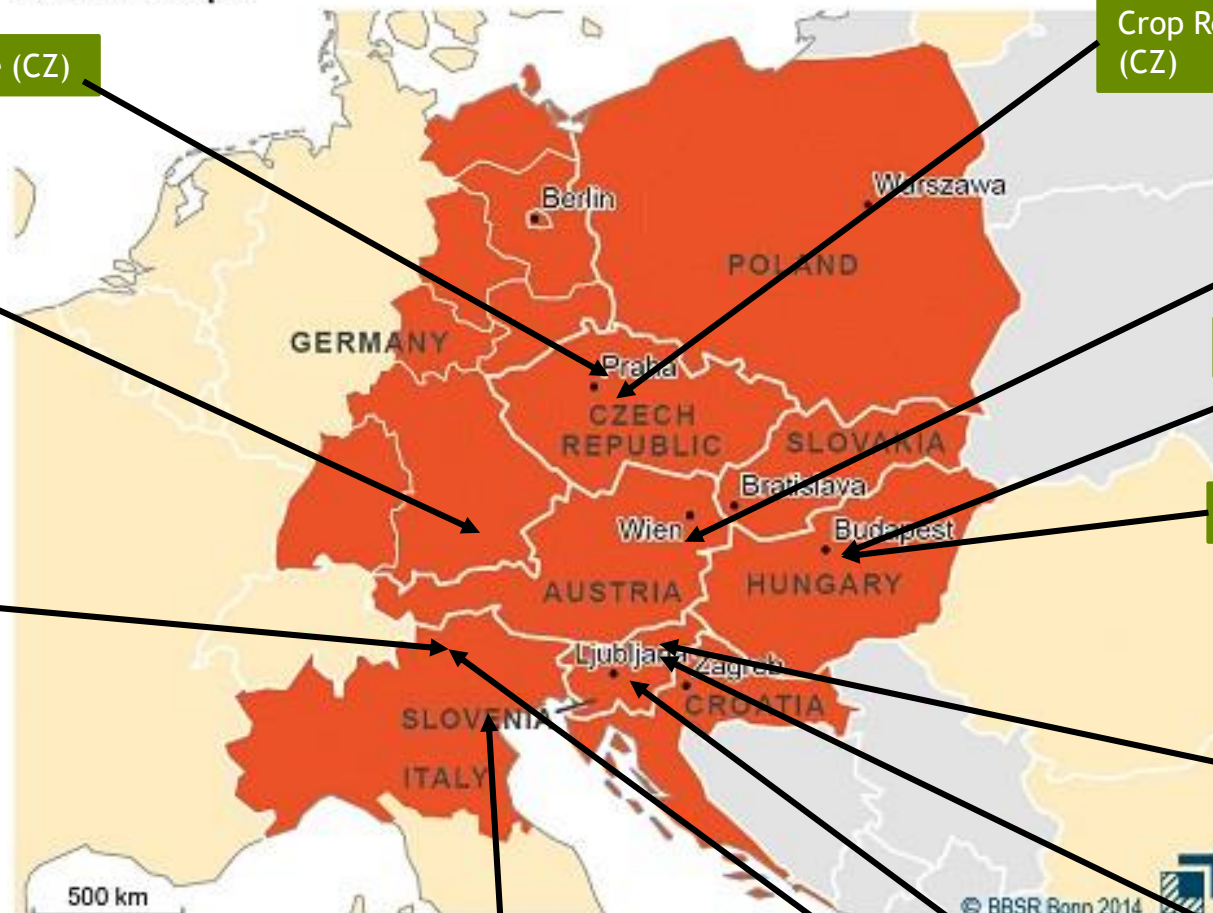


Figure 1: Hemp Cultivation Area in the EU 1993 - 2012, Source: EU Commission 2012 – data for 2012 estimation only

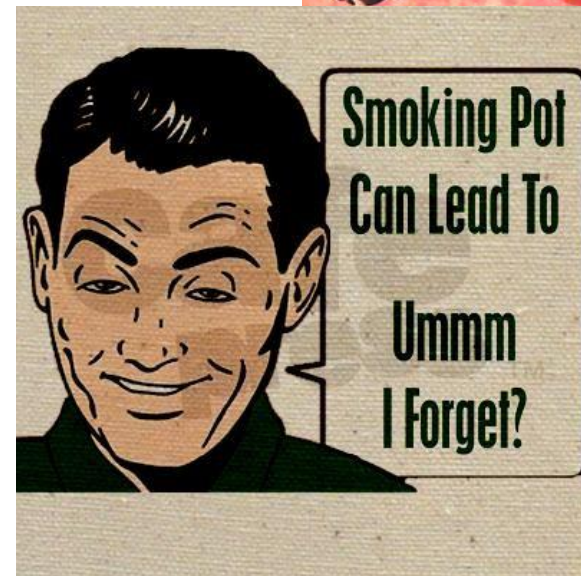
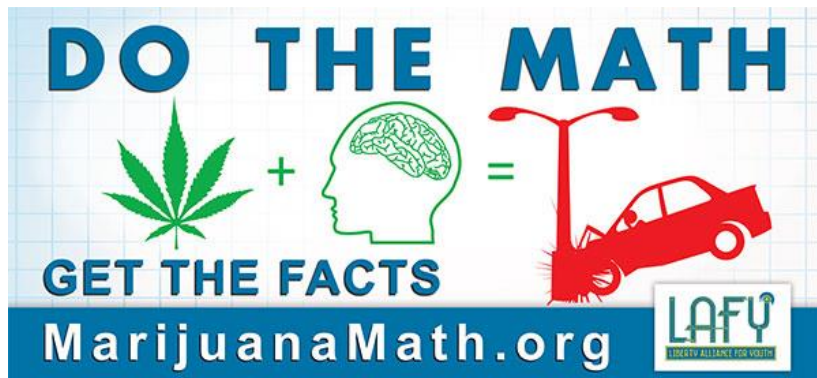
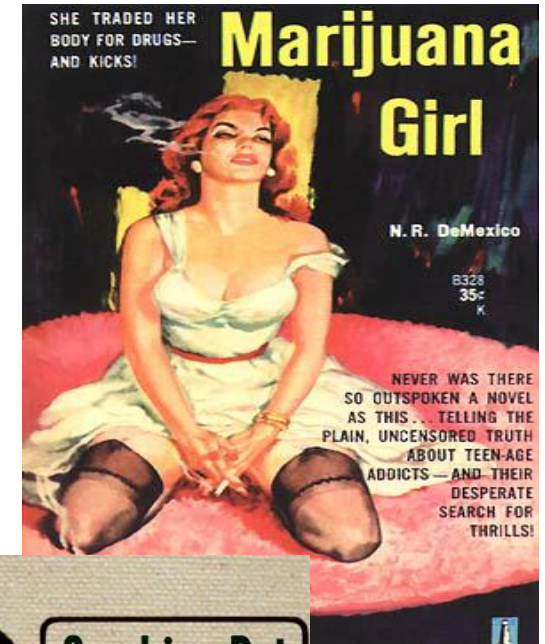
