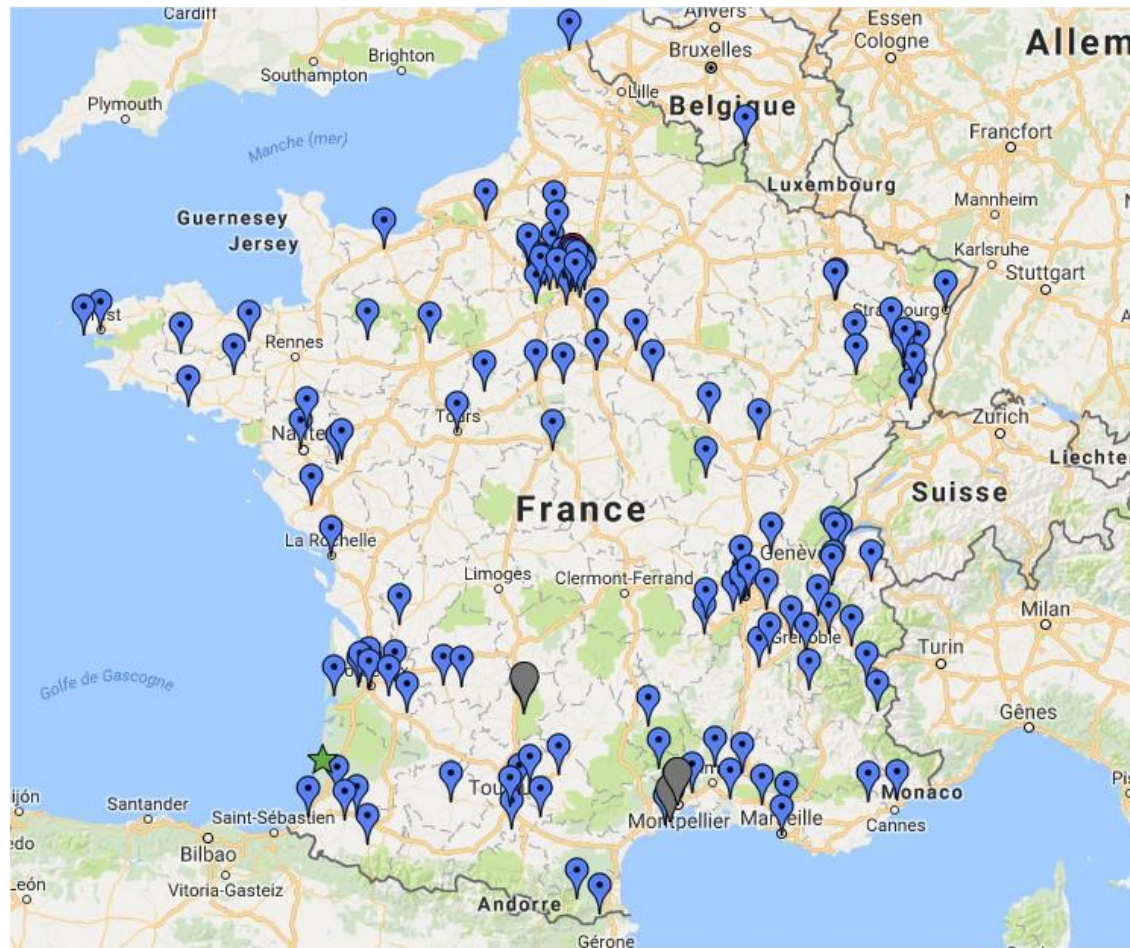

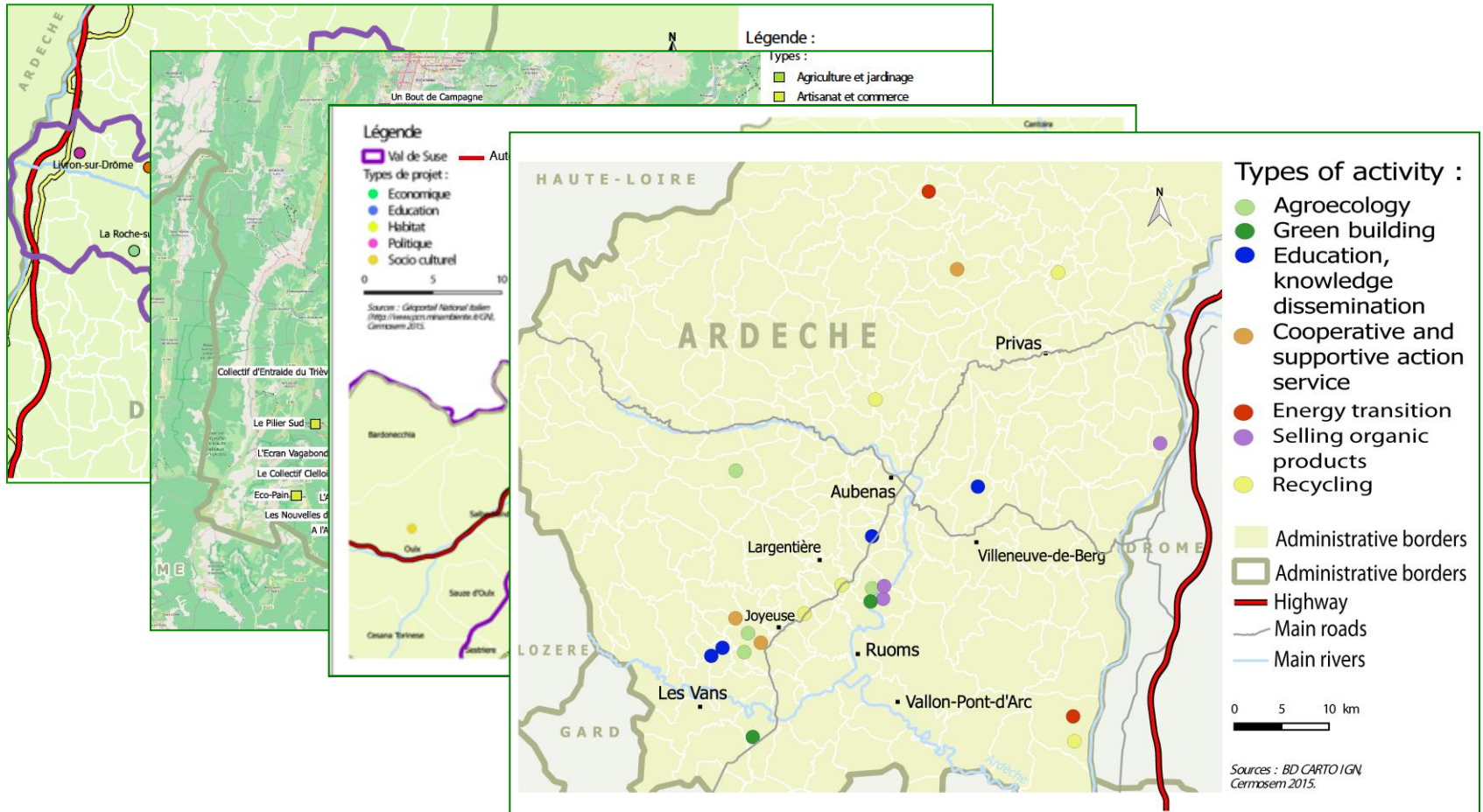

Underlying values of alternative initiatives challenging some fundamental principles of Modernity

Alternative values*	Characteristics of modern societies**
Living with nature , preservation of natural resources	Transformation of nature , overuse of natural resources
Sharing, caring, conviviality , inter-generational living, become independent from money	Individualism, competition
Local economy	Globalized economy
Autonomy, independence , self – sufficiency, creativity, community, pooling of resources and collective action	Division of labor , industrialism, trust in abstract system
Self blossoming , learning by doing	Expert knowledge - expert systems
Frugality	Growth – accumulation – consumerism
Deceleration	Most effective use of time
More circular thinking, personal journey	Rationality - linearity – progress
Horizontal translocal networks	Hierarchic structure, control, order , regulation
Diversity	Standardization, homogenization
Partial local re-embedding	Disembedding of social relations from local context
Reflexivity	Reflexive ordering and reordering of social relations
Humanised technology	Technology

= ***“alternative lifeworlds”, “places of difference”, “cosmopolitan localism***

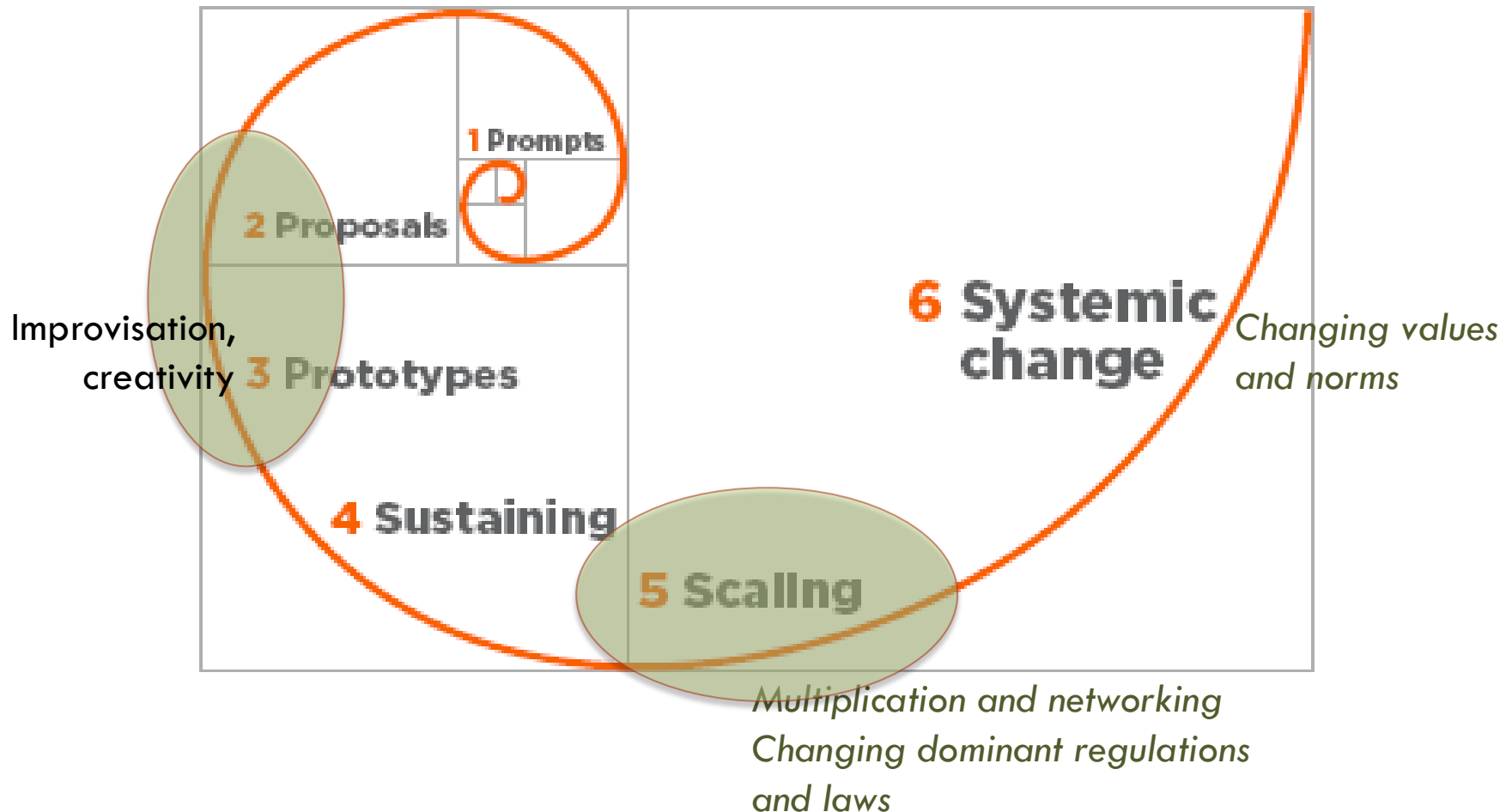
